#### **Visitor Parking**

#### Sunday

For students checking in to the dorm Sunday, no parking fees apply.

#### Monday - Tuesday

Day and overnight campers who will have a vehicle on campus must obtain a visitor permit at the <u>PARKING WEBSITE</u>.

Be sure to purchase a 3-day permit, for June 17-19. All parking areas are monitored with license plate recognition (LPR) technology. The license plate itself is the identifying marker for your parking permit. Do <u>NOT</u> back in; the license plate must be visible. Visitor permits are valid in the following lot types: yellow staff / faculty lots, green student lots, orange remote lots, and red resident reserved lots.

#### Wednesday

Families who park on campus to check their campers out of the dorm and/or attend the final program must obtain a 1-day visitor permit. The same notes apply as for the Monday - Tuesday information above. Leaving your vehicle in the dorm lot during the final performance is recommended, to save garage parking fees.

Families and guests who will *only* attend the final program on Wednesday are encouraged to park in the Meadow Street Parking Garage (MSPG on <u>this interactive campus map</u>). The parking fee is \$1.90 per hour. Note your vehicle's license plate information, proceed to a kiosk, and pay by debit/credit card. From the garage walk left up Meadow St. Follow the sidewalk left at Stadium Dr to Barnhill Arena (JBAR on the interactive campus map).

Allow at least 20 minutes to park, pay, and walk to the program site.
