Families and guests who will attend the final performance should park in the Stadium Drive Parking Garage (SDPG on this interactive campus map). Park in a numbered spot (not in a blue reserved spot), note your vehicle's license plate information, proceed to a kiosk, and pay by debit/credit card. Kiosks are located at the garage entrance, and on the second and third floors near the elevators. Take the elevator to level 4, at Garland Ave. Allow 15 minutes to park, pay, and make your way to the performance hall. </p>
